Main fabric (body of case/tote, pockets)	¾ yard
Lining fabric (lining of case/tote, pockets)	¾ yard
Coordinating fabric (bindings, straps, handle, zipper pulls)	¾ yard
ByAnnie’s Soft and Stable <sup>OR</sup> Pellon or Boasl	18" x 58"
Fusible interfacing	2" x 11½"
Mesh fabric	12" x 13"
Handbag zippers #4.5 or # 5 Handbag zippers	one 24" two 15"
1" polypro strapping	2¼ yards
1" hardware 1" D-rings or triangle rings 1" swivel hooks 1" wide-mouth slider	Two 1" rings Two 1" hooks One 1" slider
Fold-over elastic, 20mm	1½ yards

**BEFORE CLASS: To make best use of class time, please complete these steps  
BEFORE coming to class:**

1. Cut out AND QUILT the fabric and Soft and Stable according to the Cutting & Quilting Instructions in Pattern.
2. From the quilted and coordinating fabric, cut out the pieces for the project as directed.
3. Use the labels on the Companion page to label the pieces as you cut.
4. fuse stabilizer to pocket & border as noted in pattern (coordinating fabric.)
