Fusible interfacing	2" x 11½"
Mesh fabric	12" x 13"
Handbag zippers #4.5 or # 5 Handbag zippers	one 24" two 15"
1" polypro strapping	2¼ yards
1" hardware 1" D-rings or triangle rings 1" swivel hooks 1" wide-mouth slider	Two 1" rings Two 1" hooks One 1" slider
Fold-over elastic, 20mm	1½ yards

BEFORE CLASS: To make best use of class time, please complete these steps <u>BEFORE</u> coming to class:

- 1. Cut out AND QUILT the fabric and Soft and Stable according to the Cutting & Quilting Instructions in Pattern.
- 2. From the quilted and coordinating fabric, cut out the pieces for the project as directed.
- 3. Use the labels on the Companion page to label the pieces as you cut.
