Supply List:

- * Embroidery Machine, accessories, sewing attachments and foot pedal if needed.
- * No Show Mesh or cut away stabilizer to fit your hoop
USB to put embroidery files onto
- * Fabric for project - Cotton prints
- * Quilt batting
- * Embroidery thread – White, black, orange, red, 2 shades green, golden yellow,
2-3 shades of brown
- * Scissors, appliqué scissors, rotary cutter with blade and ruler, cutting mat.
SF101 interfacing or medium weight iron on interfacing. Iron onto back of center panel
background fabric and appliqué pieces

Heat & Bond or other type fusible applique backing. Iron onto back of appliqué pieces
for blanket stitch option.

Precut Fabric – Quality cotton is best. Prewash to prevent shrinking if project washed

Plain Background Option Single Hooping:

Stabilizer: Cut to minimum 17" length or to 32" in length to cover the length of project.

Quilt Batting - 11" x 32"

Center Panel Back - 11" x 32" I used white on white print.

Backing Panel for back of project – 13" x 32"

Quilted Background Option Three Hoopings:

Stabilizer: Cut (1 center) 15" length. Cut (2 ends) 13" length.

Quilt Batting - Cut (1 center) 11" x 15" length. Cut (2 ends) 11" x 13" length.

Center Panel Back - Cut (1 center) 11" x 15" length. I used White on White print.

Cut (2 ends) 11" x 13" length.

Backing Panel for back of project – 13" x 32"

Scallop borders for ends: Cut (2) 9" x 3"

Flanged inset border:

Narrow inset - 1 ½" x 33"

Wide outside border – 2 ¾" x 33"

Flat inset border:

Narrow inset - 1" x 33"

Wide outside border – 2 ¼" x 33"

Appliqué Pieces:

1. Snowbank at bottom - 9" x 3"
2. Pine tree – Trunk – 4" x 1 ¼" Tree – 12" x 3", Birch tree – (2) 12" x 2 ½"
3. Snowman body – 10" x 6"
4. Nose – 1 ¼" x 3"
5. Hat – 3 ½" x 4 ½"
6. Hat brim – 1" x 3"
7. Scarf neck piece – 2" x 4"
8. Scarf tie piece – 3" x 3 ½"
